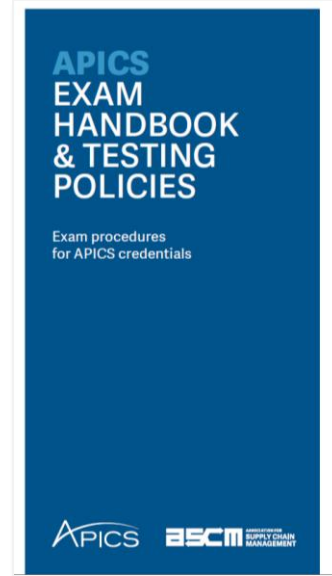
Web-based study tools

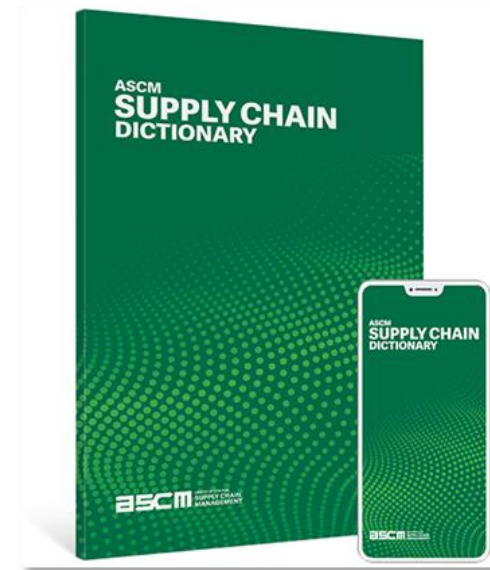
